The Department started functioning independently in 1974 and Professor Muhammad Aslam was appointed as the Chairperson. Under his guidance, the department continued to progress. Prof. Dr. Mujahid Rasul took the Chairmanship from Prof. Muhammad Aslam in 2006. Under his leadership, the department flourished a lot. In 2009, Prof. Khalid Javed was appointed as Head of Department. Since 2013, Muhammad Asif Shami is leading at front.
