Education breeds confidence, confidence breeds hope, hope breeds peace- Confucius.

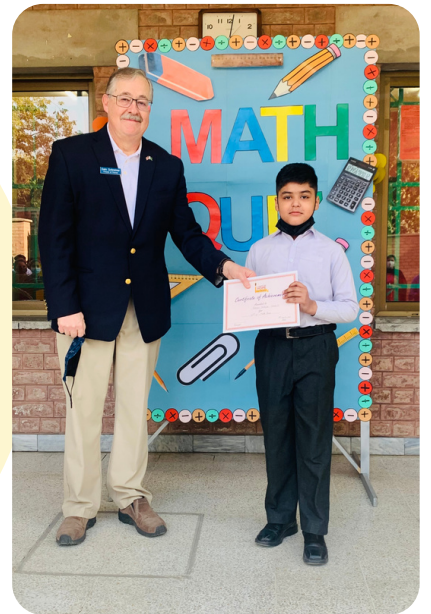
