






The chart shows the society engagements and online events conducted by various societies during Spring Semester 2021.




COMPETITIONS


CALLIGRAPHY



NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS



Day International Research Conference Networking Workshop





The office has faced unique challenges this year, however, student education has not been disrupted by the pandemic. During lockdowns, the office actively facilitated students from remote areas like Waziristan, Balochistan, Gilgit, and FATA, as well as students facing internet connectivity issues. The Residential Life Office ensured that these students had access to adequate internet services so that no student was deprived of education.

In response to the pandemic, the Residential Life Office and Financial Aid Office provided hostel financial aid to needy students. Resident Assistants were hired for the period of 2021-2022. Resident Assistants are vital to maintaining a safe and welcoming environment for the residents, and they help the Hostel Guardians in managing tasks. In return, the Residential Life Office facilitates the Resident Assistant with free accommodation and a mess scholarship.






FORMER GOVERNOR OF BALOCHISTAN VISITED GRISWOLD HALL IN JAN' 21










Presenting opportunities for the holistic growth of FCCU students, the International Education Office facilitates students and provides guidance to those interested in an international education experience. The office is dedicated to enhancing the student learning experience by offering new avenues for growth in an increasingly globalized world. Numerous information sessions were conducted online to offer guidance and support, including UGRAD information sessions and the 2021 International Education Expo.

In 2021, the office saw great success with 19 postgraduate scholarships published. Ten students were selected for an online Summer 2021 term, and 8 were provided with the opportunity to study in leading international institutions for Fall 2021.

The Campus Counseling Center is integral to student life at FCCU. 
