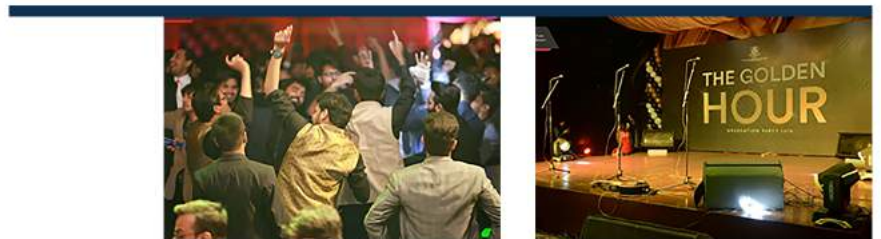
Women Entrepreneurship Fiesta 2018
