CHRISTIAN STUDENT SUPPORT FUND PROGRAM

The Forman Church Relations Office in line with the motto of Forman Christian College University disbursed around Rs. 4.4 million as financial assistance to the 377 bright and needy Christian students (college and university) in the year 2020 - 2021.

SPECIAL EVENING COACHING CLASSES - 2021

The eight weeks Special Evening Coaching Classes aims to train the Intermediate students (1st & 2nd years) for the BISE annual exams. In addition to revision and test sessions, the students are equipped with problem/question-solving techniques of the Board exams. The classes started on February 15, 2021 and were concluded on March 31, 2021. The subjects taught include Pre-Medical, Pre-Engineering & I.C.S (Computer group). All 61 students benefitted from these classes supervised by 18 Christian Faculty members. No tuition fee was charged from the students except the registration fee.




A THREE DAY SEMINAR ON "HOW TO ATTEMPT BISE PAPERS"

A three days seminar was arranged from March 6, 2021, to March 9, 2021, to guide the students of the 1st & 2nd year on "How to Attempt BISE Papers". During the seminar, students were provided with the following opportunities.

- 1. Samples of good attempted BISE papers of previous years were shown to the students
- 2. Instructions were given on time management
- 3. The students were guided about the amount of content to be written in a short or a long question

4. They were instructed about the good paper presentation; where to use a marker; what to underline; how to draw a labeled figure; where to give points; where to write paragraphs; how to facilitate examiner while marking your paper and above all how to make paper eye-catching etc.





SUPPORTING AND ENCOURAGING LOCAL CHURCHES THROUGH PRE-COLLEGE SUMMER PROGRAM - 2021

Forman Church Relations Office provides services to Christian Churches through several events and activities. Pre-college Summer Coaching Classes is one of such activities that make a difference in the lives of young boys and girls of various churches and denominations. For the current year, out of four hundred and ninety-four students from all over Punjab, hundred and eighty-eight students are registered for the Pre-college Summer Coaching Classes.

The Forman Christian College is wildly enthusiastic for shaping the lives of these students who belong to 150 different churches and denominational groups. Through mentoring, tutoring, and counseling, Forman Christian College aims to help these students build self-esteem, connect with others, give back to their churches/communities, and set goals for their future.

OPENING CEREMONY OF PRE-COLLEGE SUMMER PROGRAM - 2021

The Opening Ceremony of the Pre-college Summer Coaching Classes was held on August 26, 2021. Rev. Dr. Qaiser Julius. Chairman Board of Governors, graciously accepted for being a Chief Guest. It was not possible to invite students, parents, and church leaders in person because of the restrictions imposed by NCOC. However, students and parents joined us virtually. Dr. Jonathan S. Addleton, Rector FCCU, Dr. Douglas Trimble, Vice-Rector University, Dr. Nayer Firdous, Registrar FFC, and heads of the various department participated in person.





The Pre-college Summer Coaching Classes is one of the most important activities of the Forman Church Relations Office. 

SPIRITUAL AWAKENING THROUGH SPECIAL BIBLE STUDY CLASSES


