> ITS has designed and developed new portable attendance machines which can be used to mark attendance for events on campus. In addition, these machines can be utilized for multiple purposes. Following are some examples:

- 1. These machines are useful for checking the invitees to attend the event. This will ensure better access control and security at the events.
- These are particularly useful for recording statistical data of visitors. For instance, this can be used to compute number of students visiting job fair on various filter criteria like program of study, gender, class etc.

Each portable machine comprises of the following:

- 1. Biometric scanning device
- 2. Batteries
- 3. Portable stand

Educause Survey

TECHNOLOGY AT FCCU

Information Technology Services collaborates with Educause, center for analysis and research, to conduct a survey at FCCU on annual basis. In the year 2017, the results on how effectively the technology is utilized and is useful were quite impressive. The results also depicted the effectiveness of technology to enhance student learning. A total of 521 (n) students responded and total population size was 3554 (N).

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Conducting quizzes on Moodle helps save paper and provides an instant response to students and faculty. Here is how you can create quizzes online:




Empower; Marking Student Attendance Online
