Training and Facilitation Sessions for Faculty;

TECHNOLOGY FOR TEACHING, EMERGENCE OF DIGITAL PEDAGOGY AT FORMAN CHRISTIAN COLLEGE (A CHARTERED UNIVERSITY)

Digital Pedagogy is precisely not about using digital technologies for teaching, rather, about approaching those tools from a critical pedagogical perspective. So, it is as much about using digital tools thoughtfully as it is about deciding when not to use digital tools and about paying attention to the impact of digital tools on learning.

Digital Pedagogy is becoming increasingly influential in terms of promoting facilitated learning by utilizing technological tools. Information Technology Services in collaboration with Centre of Learning and Teaching has been providing training/facilitation sessions to the faculty of Forman Christian College (A Chartered University)

Due to this valuable initiative of training faculty 3 training sessions –for the Spring Semesterwere conducted for faculty on use of various teaching tools in classroom technology at FCC. The training focused on three types of instructors; a. white board users b. PowerPoint users c. technology integrators. The training comprised of not only understanding the use of technical tools but also how to incorporate the tools in traditional pedagogical practices by highlighting the practical implications during lectures. This included use of these tools to:

- 1. Deliver lectures more efficiently to overcome the learning barriers by incorporating and utilizing technology
- 2. Use Audio Visual aids for learning
- 3. Notes/discussion sharing
- 4. Saving lecture and sharing it
- 5. Use internet browsing during lecture
- 6. Get an instant feedback with regards to understanding of lecture for students through smart phones. In addition, a training session on Moodle, at FCCU, was also conducted by Information Technology Services in collaboration with CLT. During this session following was covered:
- 1. Sharing learning resources with students
- 2. Assignment submissions online
- 3. Structuring online quizzes with instant feedback from instructor and instant marking
- 4. Maintaining weekly schedule of sharing/learning resources

Simply open lynx on your desktop and select writing pen:








Moodle; Sharing learning resources with the Students
