During the Spring 2020 shutdown precipitated by the global pandemic, everyone across the university relied heavily on technology in unprecedented ways, placing great demand on ITS to meet our every need. Now that the college and university have adopted blended modes of teaching and learning, information technology remains at the forefront of success. Kudos to the ITS team for providing it all to us during this season of need: from hardware to new applications to installations to training to emergency help. It is hard to imagine how we would be able to function without ITS as the central nervous system of FCCU.

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Establishment of Work-from-Home plan for the FCCU staff and faculty during Covid19

As a reponse to lockdown situation in Pakistan, Information Technology Services office established a technology support plan for work from home for the FCCU staff and faculty.

To support FCCU ITS office provided 32 laptops to staff members that did not have one for official usage. 64 virtual machines were setup to give access to staff members.

Student Card Registration during Covid19

During Covid 19 global pandemic situation, the ITS office facilitated the student card registration process by ensuring required standards of health and safety.

This was to ensure compliance of the secure safety convention at FCCU even through the time of the pandemic. For the assignment, 12 interns were hired to facilitate the process of ID card creation and registration for 2020 Fall incoming students.





Moodle (LMS) Training Sessions

During the lock-down situation in Pakistan, virtual training sessions were organized, in collaboration with CLT for faculty, on the usage of moodle. The training sessions were focused on utilizing LMS tools for optimizing learning through digital pedagogical practices.

On 13th July, 2020, a training session was facilitated by Mr. Shakir Gill with regards to moodle grade book. The session focused on grading assessments, establishing grading categories/elements, computing overall grades as per FCCU grading policy and exporting grades from courses on Moodle.

On 10th August, 2020, a training session was conducted for intermediate faculty on Moodle basics. The training focused on access to moodle faculty accounts, managing course page, sharing content with students and notifications to students in classes. On 12th August, 2020, another training session was conducted for the intermediate faculty on Moodle quizzes. On 13th August, 2020 yet another session was organized focusing on creating and assessing assignments on Moodle. The above-mentioned sessions were conducted by Mr. Shakir Khurshid Gill and were very well received by the faculty of the intermediate section at FCCU.



On 12th August, 2020, a training session on Big Blue Button was organized for intermediate faculty. The training focused on using tools and techniques during online synchronous classes. The session was facilitate by Mr. Raheel Robson.

Moodle LMS (Tutorials)

In addition to training sessions, number of Moodle LMS tutorials have been created for faculty. The tutorials are developed to perform various tasks on moodle. Following is the list of tutorials:


