Introduction to Music Course

Music can be another way to perceive the world and express oneself. In the aspect of 'affective experience' and 'educating feeling' for students, music has a unique and special place. Doing music is important not only for intellectual development but also for improving the quality of one's life. In terms of the music experience, tit is not interchangeable with other experiences. Music class is based on the western music, and systematic music structures. It will give the students a better understanding of the musical language to some extent. That can lead us to advanced musical literacy in the future. Our course covers the basic music theory to broaden their thinking ability more musically, and put musical skills into practice.

We are using multimedia in every class to make the students understand music more effectively. Undoubtably, this is a good approach to explain sound-related music phenomena. We are focused on multiple topics in our 'general music class' in step with the international music classes; how to read the music notation, sight singing skills, knowing music & making sound musically.




4. Farewell Song at the Farewell Party 3rd May 2023
