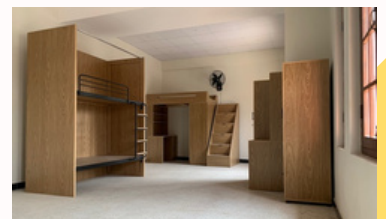

Hostel

- Currently, the small 16 beds-hostel is in use to accommodate the residents. The renovation of the hostel building is complete. In June, setup for the furniture of the new hostel has been completed, with 84 beds, therefore a total of 100 beds. To serve the ~100 female students, several new hiring position is also in process.

Needle Craft Center (NCC)

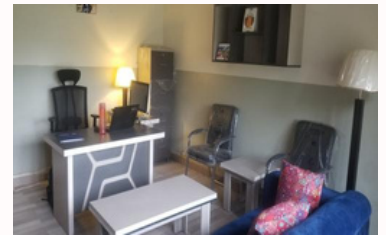
- NCC is continuing with its regular sales. During April to June, knitting group ladies delivered child long sleeves, cardigan and waist coat with good quality, and Christmas decoration group delivered ~ 500 pcs of decent Christmas decorations.

Physiotherapy Center (PC)

- The Physiotherapy Center provides services to both Special Children of TSA School and outdoor patients. We are grateful for Mr. Peter's (Taiwanese American) arrival in early-May, he has started the orientation during end-May to June, to enable a further development on Physiotherapy Center future direction and plan.

Christian Care Counseling Center (CCCC)

- CCCC is newly opened for Trauma Care & Research and Training in the area of Trauma. Mr. Qadesh was selected as a project coordinator of CCCC out of 19 applicants. This is a big achievement of the Center. CCCC is planning to lead a training program of PFA (Psychological First Aid-WHO program) for Training of Trainers(ToTs) and Trainees in early August at TSA.



Forman Psychological Service Center (FPSC)

- Since April, FPSC had three trainee clinical psychologists coming who were being trained as a part of their professional Masters degree for Child Placement by our Clinical Psychologist, Miss Rameen Babar.
- During May 2024, FPSC staff rigorously participated as the members of organizing committee of the 1st international psychology conference organized by Department of Psychology, Forman Christian College University.
- We have conducted two psychological workshops led by esteemed professionals in the field of psychology. One was conducted on the month of June by Miss Nazish Habib on the topic 'CBT for Psychosis'.
- Other than that, we have our psychotherapy sessions going on with our incoming clients.

TSA Certificate Renewal with Punjab Social Welfare:

- All the required documents were prepared to apply for the certificate renewal of Punjab Social Welfare.

Claim of annual financial assistance during 2020-2023 to Punjab Welfare Trust for the Disabled(PWTD):

- All the required documents were prepared and submitted to Punjab Welfare Trust for the Disabled(PWTD). It was challenging to prepare all the historical documents and reports, but thanks to the sincere effort of Mr Zohaib Zakria and Mrs Barsila John, our claim was approved and TSA received Rs 1,700,000 (USD 6,100).

Apply for annual financial assistance during 2024-2025 to Punjab Welfare Trust for the Disabled(PWTD):

- At the same time, we also applied for annual financial assistance in next year. All the required documents were prepared and submitted to PWTD. TSA Executive Director along with management team also had a productive meeting with Dr. Azhar Ul Haq Hashmi, Program Director of PWTD. We shared our gratitude toward PWTD's continuous support since 1998, and they appreciated the commitment and effort of TSA to nurture and empower special needs children in Pakistan.
